Resumo: Revisão de estruturas gramaticais: perguntas, negativos, there is/are, comparativos e superlativos.

1. Perguntas com auxiliares

- **Present Simple:** Do/Does + sujeito + verbo? → Do you like pizza?
- **Past Simple:** Did + sujeito + verbo? → Did you go to school?
- **Going to:** Am/Is/Are + sujeito + going to + verbo? → Are you going to travel?
- **Wh-questions:** What, Where, When, Who, Why, How + auxiliar + sujeito + verbo?

2. Frases negativas

- **Present Simple:** sujeito + don't/doesn't + verbo → I don't like coffee.
- **Past Simple:** sujeito + didn't + verbo → She didn't go to school.
- **Going to:** sujeito + am not/isn't/aren't + going to + verbo → I'm not going to swim.

3. There is / There are

- **There is (There's):** singular → There is a book on the table.
- **There are:** plural → There are three cats in the garden.
- **Negativo:** There isn't / There aren't → There isn't a car in the street.
- **Pergunta:** Is there...? / Are there...? → Is there a pharmacy near here?

4. Comparativos

- **Adjetivos curtos (+ed):** +er → taller, smaller, faster
- **Adjetivos longos:** more + adjetivo → more beautiful, more expensive
- **Irregulares:** good → better, bad → worse, far → farther
- **Estrutura:** A is + comparativo + than + B → Lisbon is bigger than Porto.

5. Superlativos

- **Adjetivos curtos:** the + adjetivo + est → the tallest, the smallest
- **Adjetivos longos:** the most + adjetivo → the most beautiful
- **Irregulares:** good → the best, bad → the worst
- **Estrutura:** A is the + superlativo + of/in + grupo → She is the tallest of the class.

6. Mapa de Conceitos

Relações: Perguntas (auxiliares) ↔ Negativos (don't/didn't) ↔ There is/are (existência) ↔ Comparativos (A > B) ↔ Superlativos (A é o maior).
Todos são estruturas fundamentais para comunicar em inglês.
