1. a) **facto** (verificável: data) b) **opinião** (juízo de valor: waste of time) c) **dado** (estatística verificável) d) **opinião** (boring é subjectivo).
2. a) "I couldn't agree more — phones distract students during lessons." b) "That's a good point about cyberbullying, and I think..." c) **should** = recomendação/opinião forte mas não ordem; **must** = imposição — inadequado num debate entre pares.
3. b) — reconhece o argumento do outro antes de apresentar o teu (estratégia de persuasão cortês) · a) e c) atacam a pessoa, não o argumento · reescrita: "I see your point, but I have a different view, because..." (ou: "I'm afraid I disagree because...").
4. a) **will come** (horário oficial → previsão segura) b) **might change** (nobody knows → possibilidade) c) **could get** (possibilidade condicionada) d) **will get** (consequência certa de um if tipo 1).
5. a) **because** (+ clause) b) **Although** (+ clause) c) **however** (ou: nevertheless) d) **Despite** (+ noun: these risks).
6. na ordem em que aparecem: "What do you think?" → 4 · "Hi everyone, here's my view..." → 1 · "Some people say..." → 3 · "In my opinion, schools should teach..." → 2.
Sequência de um bom post: **abertura** → **opinião** + **razão** → **contra-argumento reconhecido** → **fecho** + **pergunta**.
7. (modelos) a) "I couldn't agree more! I also think that..." b) "I see your point, but I'm afraid I disagree because..."
8. a-2 (proibir) · b-1 (ser a favor) · c-4 (desvantagem) · d-3 (chegar a um acordo).
9. a) **will live** (previsão com autoridade: experts predict) b) **takes / will need** (if tipo 1) c) **will appear** (ou: are likely to appear — o "likely" já marca a probabilidade).
10. a) **I agree with you.** ("agree" é verbo — sem "am") b) **In my opinion, it is bad.** (falta o sujeito *it*) c) **I think phones should be banned.** (passiva + should, ordem certa) d) **Everybody has their own opinion.** (*their* para singular *they* é o padrão moderno).
11. (exemplo) *Hi Mark, I couldn't agree more about the distractions — notifications ruined my focus too! However, I don't think a full ban is the answer: schools could teach students to use phones responsibly, for research for example. What do you think?* — concorda em *distractions*, discorda em *ban total* com frase educada.
12. (modelo) *Hi everyone, here's my view on social media for under-13s. In my opinion, a complete ban is not the answer, because children would still find ways to access it. I believe the real problem is the content, not the platform: therefore, safer versions with stronger privacy settings would be better. Some people say it damages sleep and attention — and that's a fair point, which is why I'm in favour of a time limit. Unless companies act, governments might have to regulate it in the future. What do you think — ban, limit, or educate?*
