Q1. a-1 (períodos diferentes do dia) · b-2 (de casa ou de qualquer lugar) · c-4 (por conta própria) · d-3 (subir de posição).

Q2. a) **application** b) **qualifications** (ou qualification) c) **remote** d) **automation**.

Q3. a) **will have done** (*by 2035* → perfeito futuro) b) **will be sitting** (*at 9 a.m. tomorrow* → contínuo futuro) c) **will send** (decisão no momento) d) **leaves** (horário fixo).

Q4. a) **two in three** (dois em cada três) b) **perfeito futuro + voz ativa** — *will have + V3* (adopted), com *by 2030* a marcar o prazo.

Q5. a) **will have completed** b) **will be working** c) **will have been** (duração até um momento futuro) d) **will have saved**.

Q6. a) **must** (certeza positiva) b) **can't** (certeza negativa) c) **might** (possibilidade no passado: *might have left*) d) **must** (*must have rained*).

Q7. a) **interview** b) **freelancer** (ou freelance) c) **unemployment** d) career **path**.

Q8. a) V b) F — o modal é seguido de infinitivo *sem to* ("He must be tired") c) V d) F — "Yours sincerely" usa-se quando se *conhece* o nome; com nome desconhecido é "Yours faithfully".

Q9. a) **By 2030 I will have finished my degree.** (*by + data* → perfeito futuro) b) **He must be tired.** (modal + infinitivo *sem to*) c) **As soon as I arrive, I will call you.** (depois de *as soon as* usa-se o presente).

Q10. (exemplo) *By 2032 I will have finished university and found my first job.* (perfeito futuro) · *Marta is not answering — she must be in a meeting.* (dedução) · *I would be glad to attend an interview at your convenience.* (pedido formal).

Critérios Q10: 1 v — *will have + V3* correto · 1 v — dedução com *must/can't/might* adequado; 1 v — pedido formal com "I would be glad to..."
